At the joint briefing, statements were made by Natia Turnava, Governor of the NBG, Lasha Khutsishvili, Minister of Finance and Alejandro Hajdenberg, IMF Mission Chief. The IMF's concluding statement notes that the appointment of the Governor and filling the vacant positions on the NBG Board is a welcome first step.
